Only then can my every heartbeat and breath, my least intense look, my most ordinary word, my most basic feeling be transformed into a hosanna to Christ my King” (*Christ is Passing By*, no. 181).

If personally we feel far from this goal, that is no reason to view it as impossible or to become discouraged. If we truly do what we can, God’s grace, perhaps without our realizing it, will identify our heart little by little with Christ’s.
